Thank you to everyone who donated cakes for our charity cake sale and paid to wear non-uniform. We're still in the process of counting the money so we'll let you know the total next week.

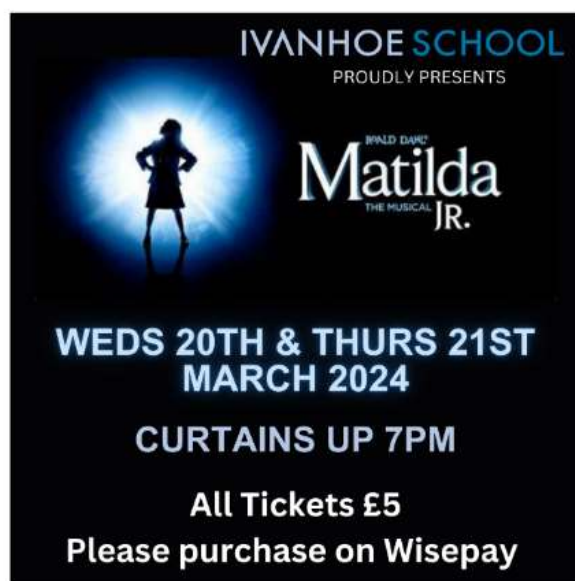

What is Clubszone Coaching Academy?

Clubszone Coaching Academy has been created for young people aged 11-16 years old. We combine learning to coach a variety of games and sports with personal character and confidence growth.

On their first day, the Junior Leaders receive a **Clubszone Coaching Pack** consisting of their very own 'Junior Leader' T-shirt, a whistle, notebook and pen, a workbook and a handbook.

What do the Junior Leaders do?

- Eat breakfast and catch up with the activity leaders
- Morning briefing and team building activities
- Set your daily targets with your camp manager
- Watch, learn and take notes from the activity leaders
- Referee games and motivate younger children through activities
- Learn to lead games with a small group of children alongside activity leaders
- Be a role model on camp
- Update your journal to track your progress
- Be a team leader in competitive games
- Join in with activities and have fun!
