Comic Relief – Friday 15th March



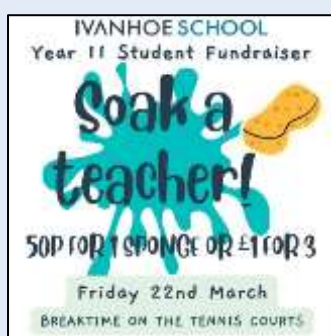

Soak the Teacher – Friday 22nd March



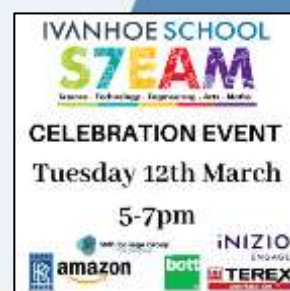
