


As a school, we are committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of every student. We will continue to educate our pupils on the devastating

Uniform Standards



At Ivanhoe we believe that our school uniform is important. By wearing the correct attire students are showing respect and pride for being part of our school community. A school uniform promotes a sense of belonging amongst students, ensuring everyone feels included and equal. Unfortunately, some students feel that uniform rules do not apply to them and so we will continue to hold students to account for uniform infringements and consequences will be given.

In our dining room every morning, 8-8.30am students can see Mr Priestland at our Uniform Hub, if they are missing uniform or wearing incorrect items to avoid consequences for the day.

As we come up to half term it is a good time for parents to check that uniform and shoes still fit correctly, and if replacements are bought that they meet the school uniform requirements. In particular can families be reminded that school trousers at Ivanhoe must be grey, and school shoes must be black.

We are clear in our expectations, shoes must be polished black leather or leather look, but still some students think they can come to school wearing other footwear, which is not acceptable.



We are also cracking down on those students who think they can get away with wearing their PE kit on non-PE days. Again, this is not acceptable and staff will be challenging it, and consequences given. Finally, can we ask parents to speak with students about manners and etiquette in school in regards to coats indoors. Coats are not to be worn in classrooms and staff should not be expected to waste lesson time asking students to remove them.

Thank you all for your support on this matter.


Safer Internet Day -February 11th 2025

School Closes at 2.00pm for Staff Training on Thursday 13th February 2025




Please make arrangements for your child to get home on this day.
