New Ashby Youth Centre – INSPIRE YOUTH COLLECTIVE



We are very pleased to be supporting a brand new not for profit youth initiative opening in Ashby, on Market Street, in January.

Mrs Cresswell and Mrs Deacon met with the centre manager – Emma Armstrong-Heath to talk about the aims of the centre, which are ambitious. The centre will not only provide a hang out space for students after school, but there will be the opportunity to sign up for activities such as crafts, gardening, life skills, movie nights and more. A small in-house café will sell affordable snacks and meals. In addition,

the centre will be running a teenage clothing bank and community kitchen at weekends, and a teen Makers Market to sell items to raise funds.

There are spaces available to rent during the day, and there are also activities for home schooled students during the day too.
