
Year 11 Revision Sessions



Lifesaving Skills For EVERYONE

Ashby Leisure Centre & Lido Thursday 12th December 2024 / 6PM-8PM

We are running a FREE lifesaving skills workshop for people within the local areal According to the British Heart Foundation, only 1 in 10 that suffer from a heart attack survive (in a non-medical location). The purpose of the session is to provide the community with first aid skills that could one day help save a family member or friend. The session will be a fun and relaxed session, suitable for adults and will be ran by RLSS trainers based at the centre. The session will include the following first aid lifesaving skills and training:

- Adult, Child and Infant Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- The use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- **Treatment for Choking**



This is a free session for the community, but we also hope to raise money for our charity partner Breast Cancer Now. Any voluntary donations on the day will be appreciated.
