Coaching, Reflection, Enrichment and Wellbeing sessions

For Year 7 and 8 students in 2025/26, we are excited to introduce Coaching, Reflection, Enrichment and Wellbeing time, which has been a huge success across other schools in our trust. The Real LiFE Curriculum is a new style of teaching and learning that is based on the latest global educational research and aims to equip our learners with the knowledge, skills and values they will need to thrive in the 21st century. It is designed to make learning relevant and more engaging by bringing topics to life, and by coaching students with the skills they need to take more control of their own learning so that they can really learn to make a positive difference not only to their own lives, but also to the world around them.

The Real Life Curriculum is coming to Ivanhoe School over the next two years, in three stages.

Stage 1 - C.R.E.W Mission lessons for Year 7 and 8 students - Thursday Period 1 (already begun)

During C.R.E.W Mission lessons students embark on various engaging missions to build knowledge and skills while growing student agency.

Stage 2 - C.R.E.W time during form time for Year 7 and 8 - Introducing target setting and personalised learning from 15th September.


Students will set personal weekly targets to give them ownership of their learning and build agency, with an initial focus on Reading, developing to include behaviour, attendance and more.

Stage 3 - Cross-curricular Missions - Currently in the planning stages, being introduced from next school year.
