

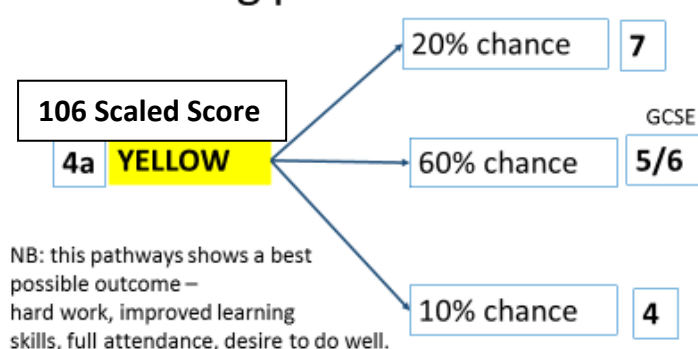
Ivanhoe Progress and Achievement Results 2016/17

As you will be aware, all schools moved away from KS3 Curriculum levels in 2015. At Ivanhoe, we transitioned to a pathway system along with 6 schools in our ACE Partnership (Ashby and Coalville Education). Our new system tracks students to GCSE. The pathway statements behind the colours reflect the skills, knowledge and understanding needed to achieve expected progress at GCSE. All our results for 2016/17 refer to this system of colours. See below.

Each colour relates to the new GCSE number system whereby grades have been replaced by numbers. The conversion below was used for 2016/17.

Student Progress: In Year 9, our results this year are based on whether students are on track to make expected or above expected progress. This chart shows the high percentage of students who are making expected or above expected progress across a range of subjects.
