

Our PSHRE and Careers programmes help our students become responsible, independent, proactive and citizens. We aim to support our students in developing a skill-set for life, centred on a range of topics and activities, enabling them to succeed in life in modern day Britain.

To meet this aim students in Year 10 and 11 will have the opportunity to gain GCSE or equivalent qualifications across a range of compulsory and option subjects.



SUPPORT & PASTORAL CARE

For each student to reach their full potential they need to feel safe, valued and supported. We are passionate about providing that safe and caring environment which is at the heart of our pastoral provision.

Each child will have a dedicated team for their year group including Form Tutors, Head of Years, School Leaders and our experienced and highly qualified SEND Team.

Our Pastoral Support Team help students navigate through behavioural and emotional challenges by offering a range of support and proven strategies which ensure success in both the classroom and in life outside of the school.





ENRICHMENT

Taking our students out of the traditional classroom and into the real world has numerous, wonderful advantages that should always be encouraged.

The Ivanhoe Curriculum is enhanced by an extensive extra-curricular programme. Clubs, trips, charity and sporting events alongside internal and external competitions enhance our academic offer.

Student Leadership is strongly embedded at Ivanhoe, examples of opportunities include: Student Council, Citizens UK, Sports Leaders, Literacy Leaders, Student Mentors, Stephen Lawrence ambassadors and the Eco Club. Students of all abilities and backgrounds are encouraged to take part not only to develop and showcase their skills, but to show our pupils that at Ivanhoe we value the Student Voice.
