How many years are there in a decade?	10
How many years are there in a century?	100
What does B.C. mean?	Before Christ
What does A.D. mean?	Anno Domini (In the year of the Lord)
When was the Middle Ages?	1066-1485
When was the Tudor period?	1485 - 1603
When was the Stuart period?	1603 -1714
What was the Industrial Revolution?	The changes that took place in industry (how things are made) in the U.K. between approximately 1750 and 1900.
When was WWI?	1914-1918
When was WWII?	1939-1945
What is a monarch?	A king, queen or emperor
What is Parliament?	The group of people who make laws in the U.K.
What are the four different types of evidence that historians use to find out about the past?	Physical evidence (buildings, pottery, coins) Written evidence (diaries, letters, documents) Visual evidence (paintings, photographs, films) Oral evidence (songs, poetry, audio recordings, spoken word)
What do historians call a piece of evidence?	A source
What word is used to describe a source that is unfairly one-sided?	Biased
What is a belief?	An idea that you accept as true.
What are values?	What a person thinks is important in life.
What is a theist?	A person who believes in the existence of God.
What is an atheist?	A person who doesn't believe in the existence of God.
